Even if you normally drive your students to school, consider having your family walk or bike into school with other Drew families for at least the last leg of your commute. Groups of walkers will form to walk to school together at the following locations and will leave for school at 7:30 a.m.:

- 1. East Lake Terrace near the churches near Memorial Drive. Parking available on East Lake Terrace and in the church parking lots.
- Alston Drive and Third Avenue Intersection. Parking available on Third Avenue.
- 3. Sheltering Arms Driveway at Villages of East Lake. Limited parking available in the leasing office lot or at Publix.

Pick a point to walk from, join the group as it walks by your location.

Everyone will arrive at school by 7:45 a.m.

Reminder: Parents, you are responsible for making sure your students arrive at school safely before 8:00 a.m.
